

# Construction Engineering and Management (CEM) MasterTrack Certificate Program Pathway to Master of Engineering in CEM

Students who have successfully completed the online MasterTrack Certificate in Construction Engineering and Management (MTC-CEM), and are then admitted to the on-campus Master of Engineering (M.Eng.) in Construction Engineering and Management program can earn 6 credits of acceleration in the graduate M.Eng. degree program.

- 1 **Successfully complete the online MasterTrack Certificate in Construction Engineering and Management (MTC-CEM)**
- 2 **Apply to the on-campus M.Eng. program**
- 3 **If admitted, earn 6 credits of acceleration in the graduate M.Eng. degree program**

Students who have completed the online MTC-CEM will only need to complete 20 additional credits of work on campus in order to obtain the M.Eng. degree instead of the regular course load of 26 credits. This option offers significant cost savings in the total tuition of the M.Eng. degree program.
